### Annual Report for the year 2018-19

1. Total number of students studying Under Graduation is 2873 and in Post Graduation there are 357 boys and 124 girls. Out of which, 103 students are Differently abled.
2. Total number of teaching Faculty is 171.
3. A sum of Rs. 5,34,586/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Thirty Four thousand Five Eighty six only) is spent towards Library Books.
4. A sum of Rs. 12,98,221/- (Rupees Twelve lakhs ninety eight thousand two hundred and twenty one only) is spent towards purchasing new equipments.
5. A sum of Rs. 80,231/- (Rupees Eighty thousand three hundred and twenty one only) is spent towards conduct of Seminar/Conference/Workshop. Department of History organised national seminar on 'Human Rights : Past & Present' on 20-3-2019 and Department of Computer Science organised national conference on 'Research Advances in Information & Communiation Technology' on 13-3-2019. IQAC conducted Training Programmes on Competitive Examinations (5-3-2019), Training programme for Placement – Spoken & Presentation Skill & Etiquettes' (7-3-2019) and Training Programme on Career Guidance – Personality Development' (11-3-2019) for students. Faculty Development Programme on 'Capacity Building for Higher Education – ICT Enabled Teaching and Learning' (9-3-2019) was organised for Faculty members by IQAC.

9. On the basis of the future course of action, the following actions taken or achieved during 2018-19
- a. Online attendance entry and entry of internal marks has been implemented. Additionally, students can view their internal marks, attendance percentage through their login.
  - b. First year students are instructed to enroll any one of the extension programmes like NCC, NSS, YRC, Yoga, Sports. If any of the students are found not registered with any one of the above extension programmes, they will not be eligible to get 2 credits by default.
  - c. Training Programme on Competitive Examinations, Placement – Spoken & Presentation Skill & Etiquettes and Career Guidance – Personality Development were held for the students of all streams on 5<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 respectively. An average of 155 students got benefited.
  - d. A Faculty Development Programme on 'Capacity Building for Higher Education – ICT Enabled Teaching and Learning' was held for all faculty members of our college on 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2019. 143 staff members attended and got benefited.
  - e. Placement Cell organised Placement Camp in the month of December, 2018. 10 companies participated in the Drive and 25 students got selected.
